VANDALISM COSTS US ALL

In recent weeks, WPHA Board members identified, reported and successfully obtained \$2,300 in reparation from the families of two vandals who damaged the Park Pool.

As a result of this incident, plus other vandalism and criminal activity occurring in the Park this summer, police officers from Precinct 5 are now patrolling the Park more frequently, at our request.

Recently Reported Incidents:

- Theft, Entering Auto, Auto Theft
- Vandalism to cars
- Bricks removed at Winchester Circle
- Animal cruelty
- Derelict vehicles left at the dock
- Dock gate damaged
- Trespassers at the dock

REMINDER: CURFEW EXISTS
